

Agde / Sète

Canal des 2 Mers by bike - Atlantic / Mediterranean sea



The town of Agde, with its ancient roots and black basalt architecture, is a startling place. Its soaring church tower looks down on the Hérault Estuary. You're now reaching the very end of the Canal du Midi à Vélo cycle route, which finishes by the massive Etang de Thau coastal lake and Les Onglous Lighthouse at Marseillan-Plage resort. From here, the superb Lido greenway runs alongside the Mediterranean up to the great port of Sète. Stop for a dip at any point!

The route

The route is not specially laid out for cyclists between Agde and neighbouring Marseillan-Plage. Then a greenway runs beside the sea up to the entrance to the port of Sète.

Gares SNCF

Agde train station:

TER regional trains serve > Béziers/Narbonne/Perpignan; Carcassonne/Toulouse; Sète/Montpellier (numerous trains daily)

Sète train station:

TER regional trains and Intercités trains serve > Agde/Béziers/Narbonne/Perpignan; Carcassonne/Castelnaudary/Toulouse/Bordeaux; Montpellier (numerous trains daily); Avignon/Marseille (3 to 4 trains daily). Connections at Montpellier for Lyon/Paris; Nîmes/Alès/Clermont-Ferrand. Connections at Béziers for Millau/ Rodez/ Clermont-Ferrand.

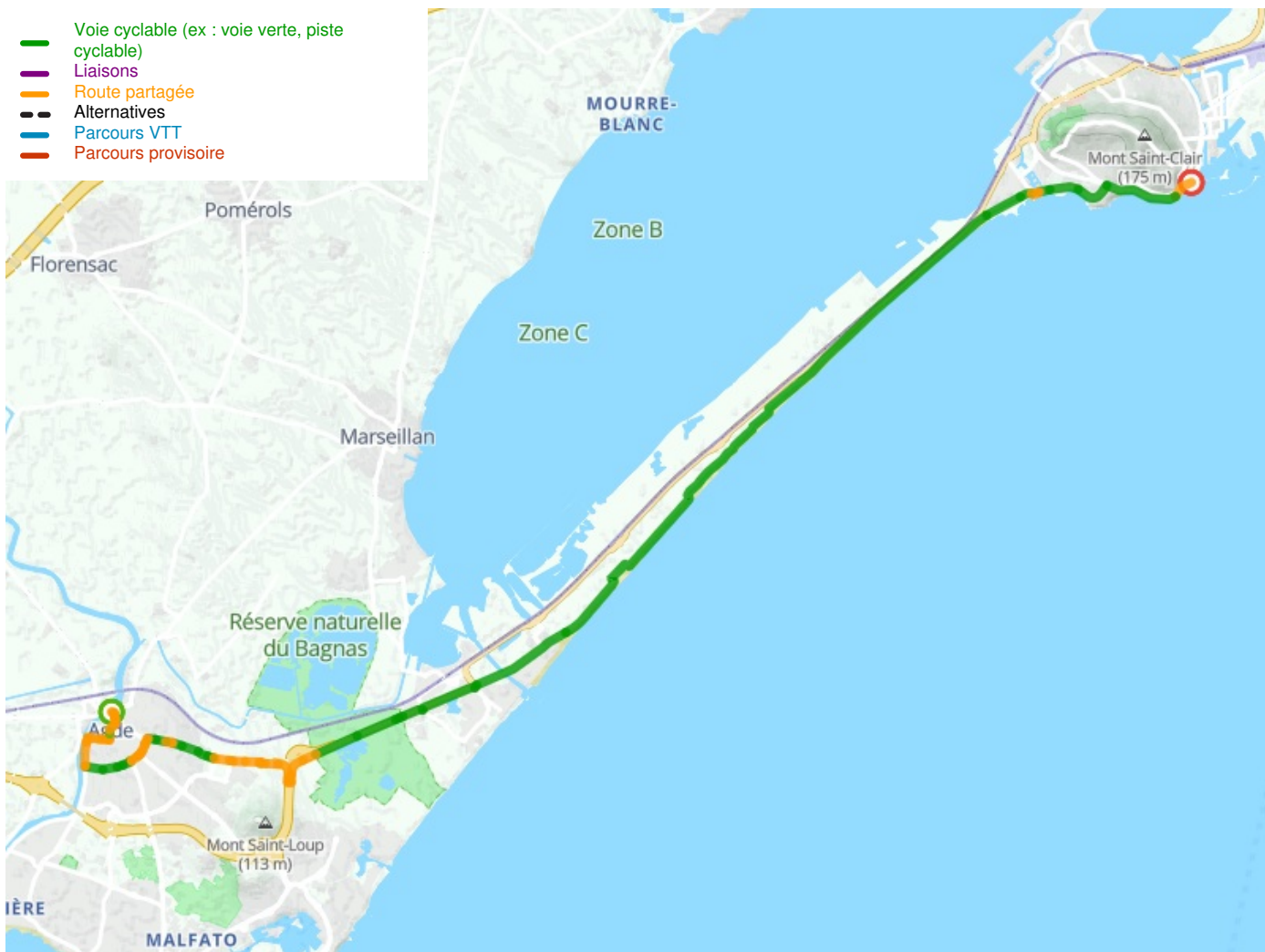

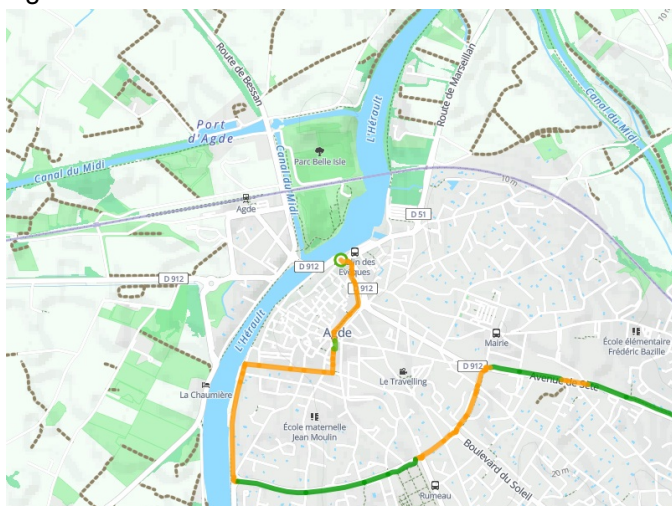
