EuroVelo 6 - Cycle Route of the rivers



This EuroVelo 6 stage in Burgundy meanders between the Canal du Centre and Bourbince River. You pass significant vestiges left from the mining and steel-making industries that long brought activity to the canal in times past. From Palinges, the atmosphere changes as you come to the Renaissance castle at Digoine. This stage is along roads.

Route

The route takes you along the D 974 road, with moderate traffic that is manageable for cyclists. After G nelard, you're on small roads, signposted to Digoine.

G nelard: impressive canal embankments, the Mus e de la Ligne de D marcation (on the World War II dividing line between occupied and non-occupied France)

Palinges: Ch teau de Digoine, with guided or unaccompanied tours of the castle.

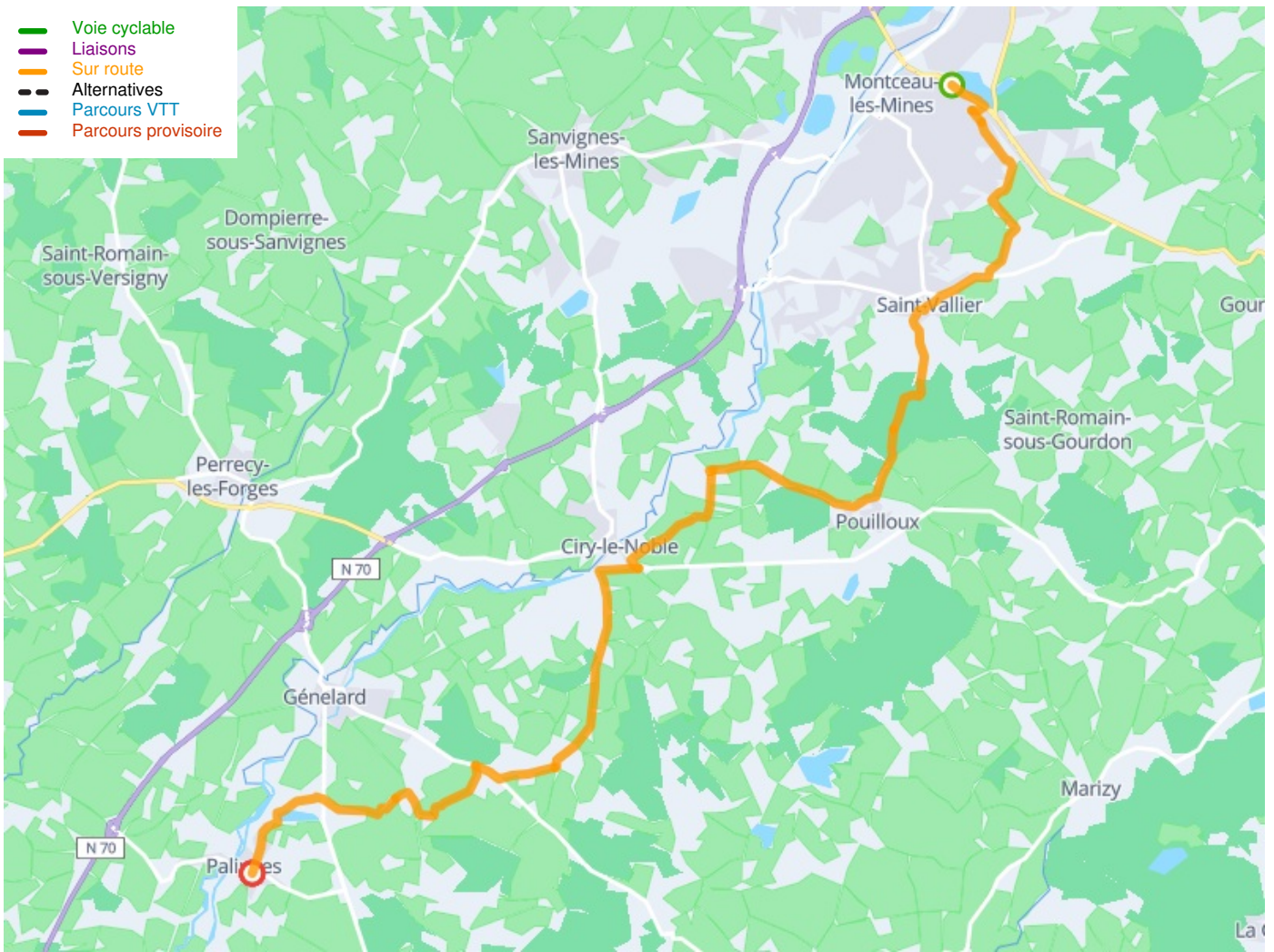

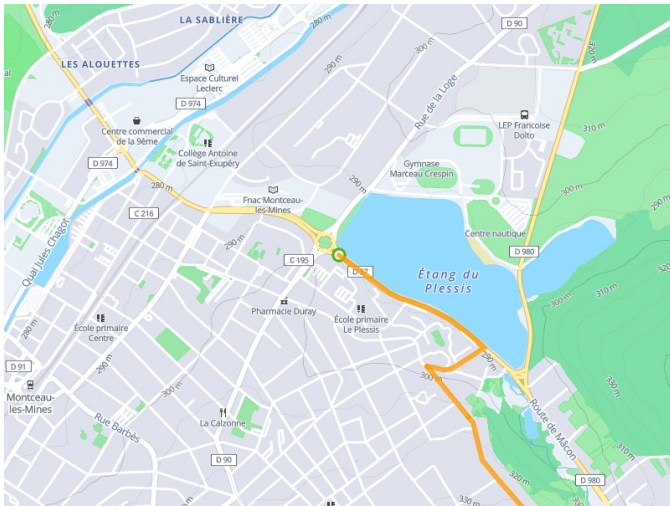
