

Châtillon-sur-Indre / Buzançais

Indre à Vélo - Indre by bike



The route keeps close to the Indre after Châtillon-sur-Indre, allowing you to wander peacefully along roads lined with a mix of fields and the occasional forest.

Midway along this stage, stop to admire Palluau-sur-Indre and its château perched on a rocky promontory, offering splendid views down on the Indre Valley. Back on your bike, it's not too long a ride to reach the town of Buzançais.

The route

Signposted route on county and smaller country roads.

Connection :

Just before the entrance to Buzançais, there's a link you can join to take you to Argy, with its tourist train, going via the D64 and D63 roads.

Tourist train + bicycle transport

The Bas-Berry railway line (it is possible to take your bike on the train):

This tourist train, a throw-back to the early 20th century, connects Argy with Valençay, taking you into the heart of the historic province of Berry.

Stations served: Pellevoisin, Heugnes, Ecueillé, Luçay le Mâle and Valençay.

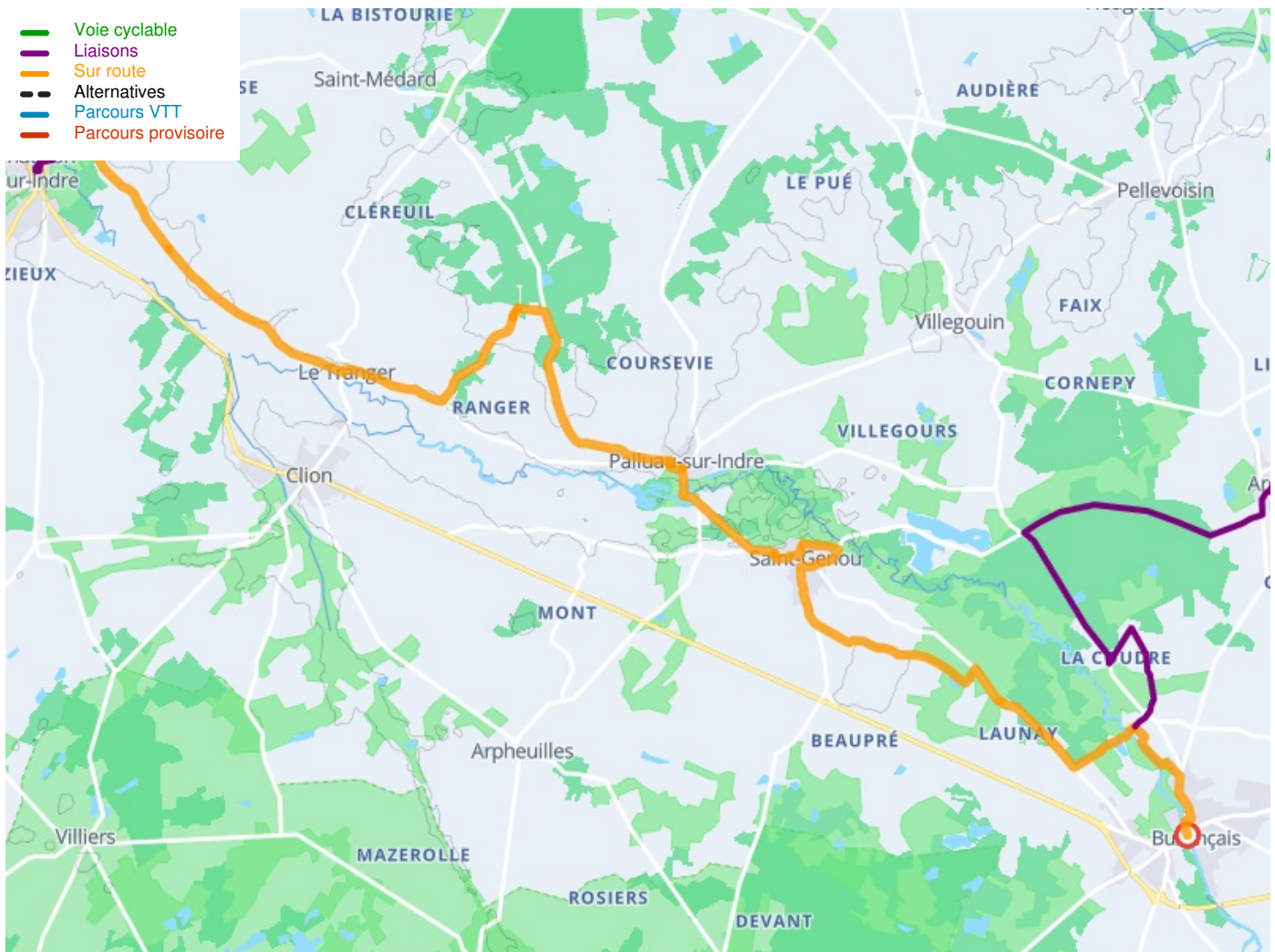

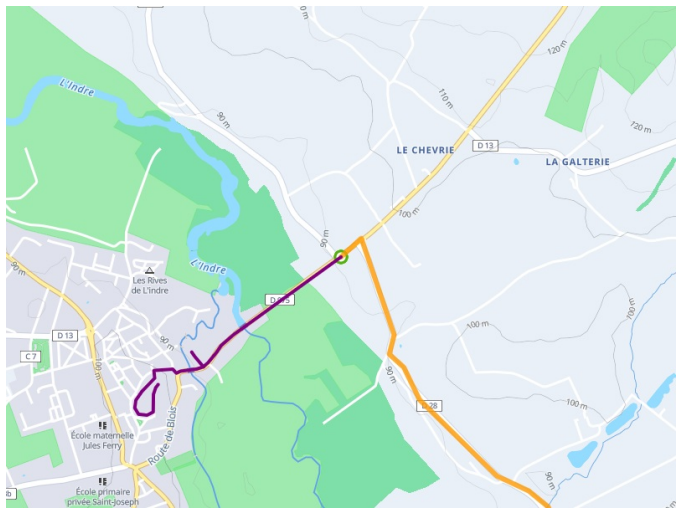
