The elegant seaside resort of Le Touquet is known for its style, for its remarkable villas set along wooded avenues, and for its wealth of cycle paths! Further seaside resorts follow along La Vélomartine, with Stella-Plage and Merlimont-Plage to cross before Berck. At Berck-sur-Mer, the final stop on this cycling stage, make the most of the immense beach, offering 12km of fine sands, stretching down to the Bay of Authie, a beautifully preserved natural area.

The route

At Etaples, cross the Pont Rose bridge using the cycle lane provided to continue on to Le Touquet.

The question of creating a cycle link between the resorts of Stella-Plage and Merlimont is under consideration, although nothing has been laid out at time of writing.

- Hiking trails allow visitors to explore the Bay of the Canche, a nature reserve sheltering an exceptionally rich biodiversity.

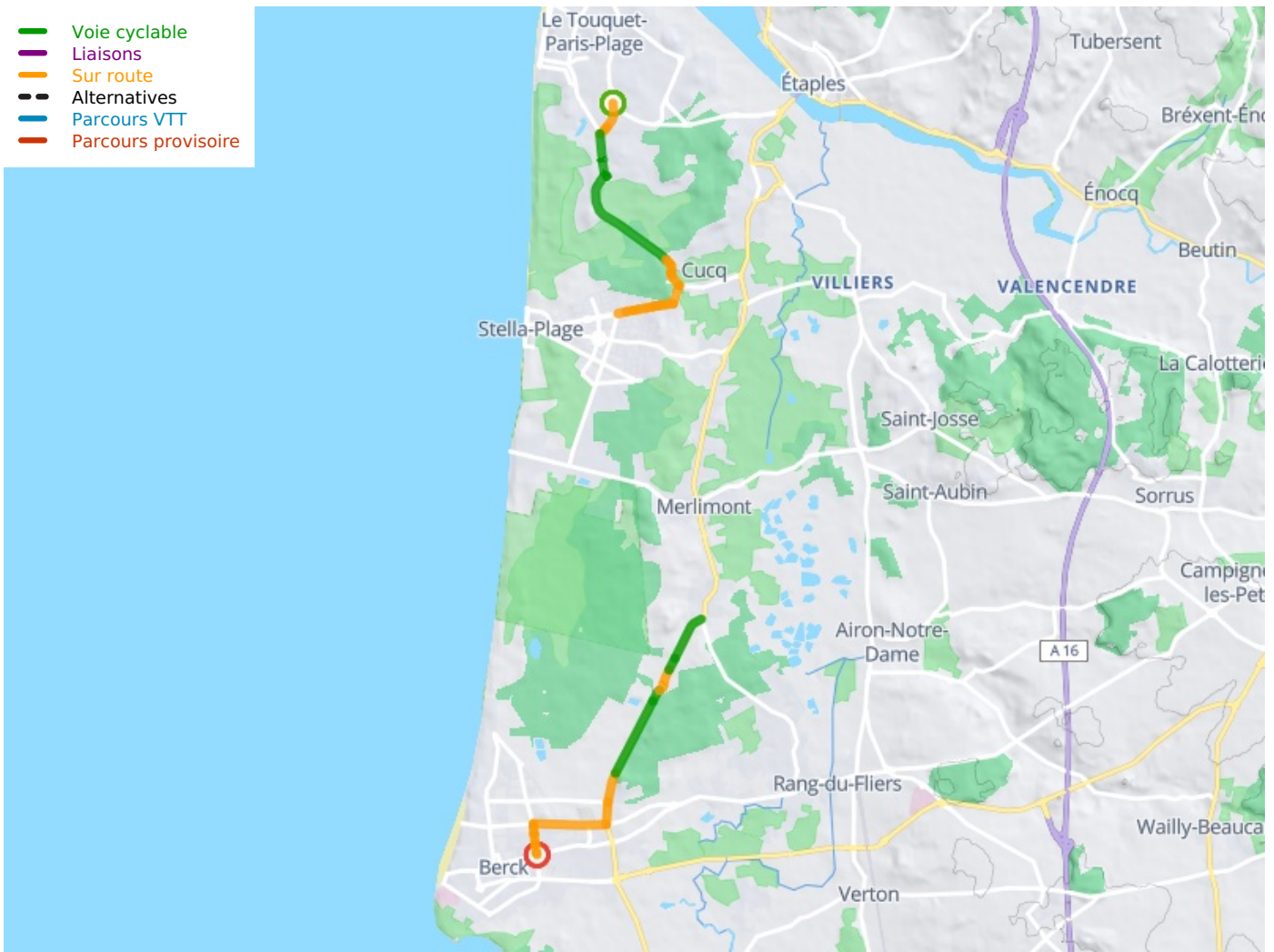
Relaxation / activities:

- You can have a go at sand-yachting as well as many other water sports along this stretch of coast, or consider [horse-riding outings](#).

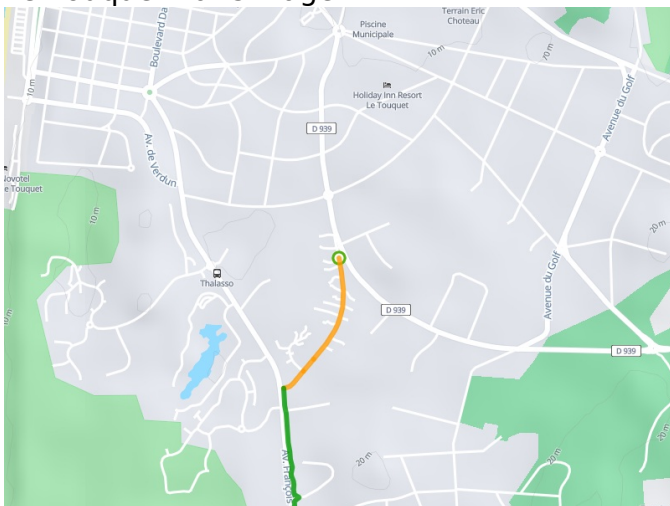
