This stage of the Eurovélo 4 route is steeped in history. Along this stretch of coast, follow in the footsteps of Sissi, ill-fated 19th-century Empress of Austria, who enjoyed bathing in the sea at Les Petites and Les Grandes Dalles and made the most of the peace at the nearby Château de Sassetot-le-Mauconduit. Also take in the breath-taking views from Senneville's coastal signal station before beginning your descent to Fécamp, an historic port long controlled by the Dukes of Normandy.


### The route

On this Eurovélo 4 stage, it's destination Fécamp, an historic port long held by the Dukes of Normandy. The route takes you close to some of the most beautiful 'valleuses' along the Côte d'Albâtre, at Veulette-sur-Mer, Les Petites Dalles, Les Grandes Dalles and Saint Pierre en Port. Even if the EV4 route doesn't strictly take you down these steep descents to the sea, make the most of their proximity to discover these natural marvels.


