On greenways, going around Yffiniac Cove. The slopes near the end do present some challenges.

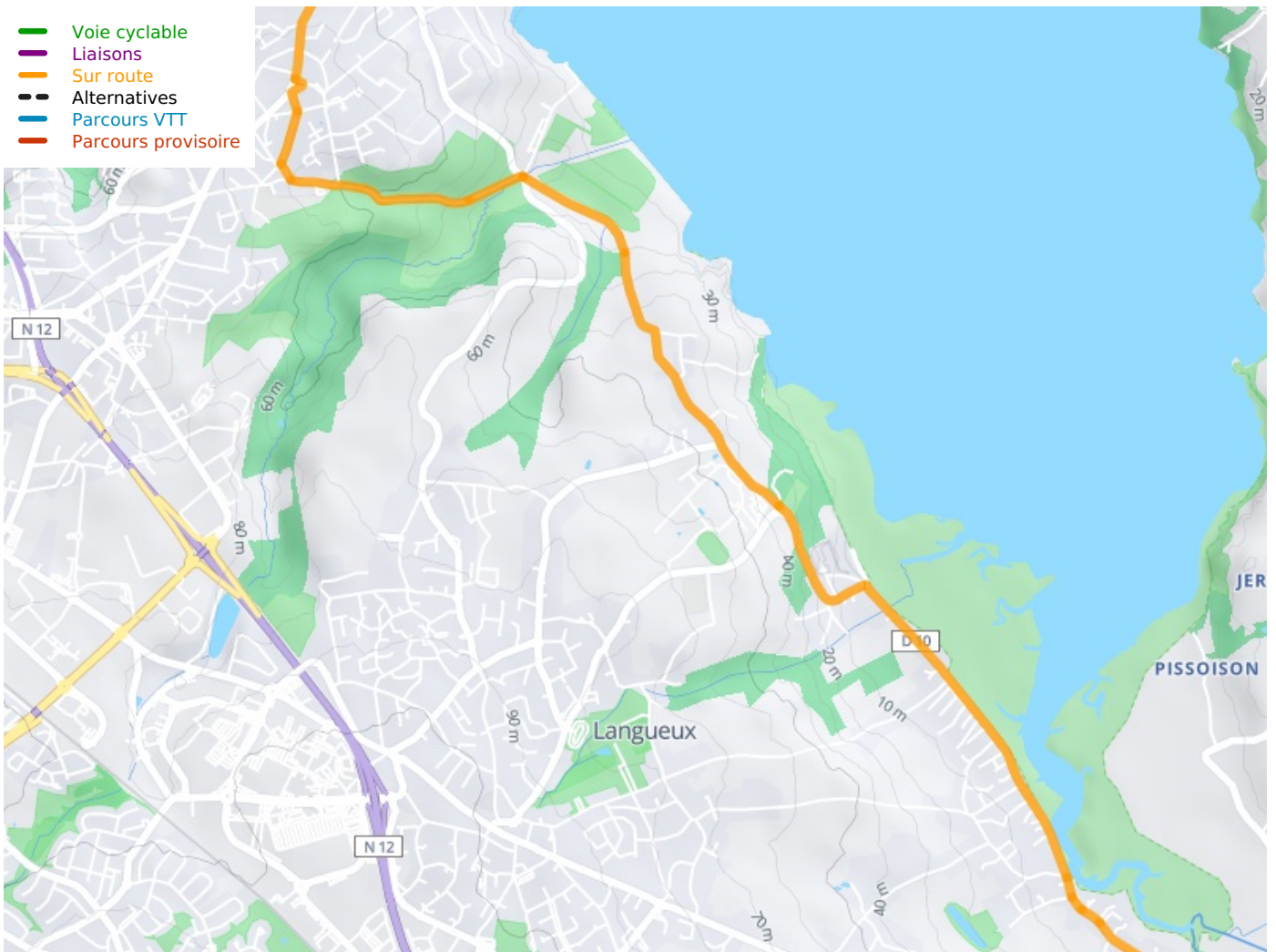

There's a link to St-Brieuc train station, going via the city's cathedral, tourist office and shopping quarters.

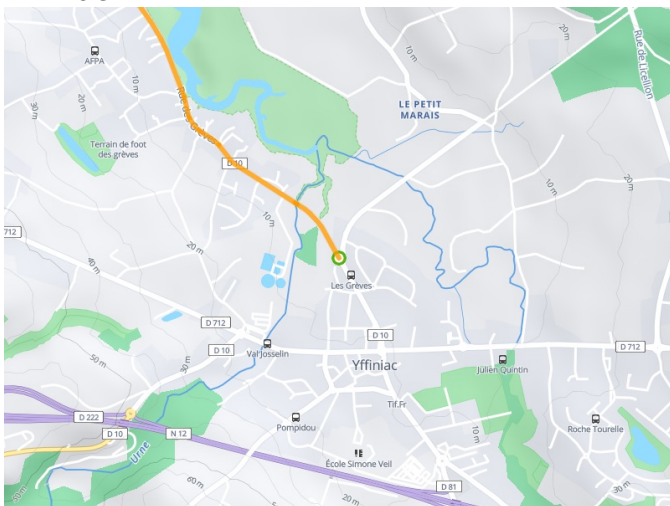
