Thématique Seaside, Nature & small Before continuing your adventure, treat yourself to one last stroll through the famous Ville Close, surrounded by 15thcentury ramparts and lively terraces. Take your bike aboard the ferry for a short 200-meter crossing to the Lanriec district. Your journey along the coastal cycle route continues to the Pointe de Trévignon, via Trégunc. This area, popular with nature lovers, is a bird paradise and the property of the Conservatoire du Littoral. Further on, the cycle route passes through the village of Névez - welcome to thatched cottage country! Following the river Aven, the last pedal strokes of this stage take you to Pont-Aven, made famous by the works of Gauguin. Here, art galleries abound, perpetuating the bohemian spirit of yesteryear.


## The route

On the whole, the route is relatively straightforward, but includes some road sections.

Please note that the V45/V5 coastal cycle route from Concarneau to Lanriec is provisional and not signposted, so you'll need to take the ferry.
